REPORTS:

A. Contract Manager Sward reported ditches will be cleaned next month; checked 2 meters that had been reported by residents having received huge water bills; will be installing lane-dots at several locations on Sunset

B. Community Center Committee: Kathy Sward spoke on their meeting of 11/13. The entire meeting was devoted to one subject, licensing for Child Care but it was not resolved. The question of capacity be listed as 11 or 19. They now have 9 children. More facts are needed and she will report back to the next CSD meeting.

A lengthy discussion followed combining Child Care/Community Center. Savage said they are operating with 12 children, 8 months to $2\frac{1}{2}$ years of age. C. Fire Chief Sward reported there is a new Captain up on Throckmorton Ridge fire station; Muir Beach will be having more drills with them. Also

has been doing maintenance work on fire trucks.

D. Emergency Preparedness: Burke reported there is a new Director for the Office of Emergency Services.

OLD BUSINESS:

Recreation Committee Bank Account: Melo reported having changed the account from a checking to savings account with \$227.65 in funds. NEW BUSINESS:

Myers spoke on permanent road division; the County would be responsible for roads, bringing them up to standard and maintain over a period of time. The people specify the width, berms, etc. They would come in and do so, cost to be paid over a period of 10 years. He will pursue and report back. CORRESPONDENCE:

A letter from Peter Lavalle regarding his October water bill being so high. The meter was checked and found to be 99% accurate.

ANNOUNCEMENTS: Kathy Sward reported having found a large TV for the Teens, at Macy's in San Francisco. 40" diagonal Mitsubishi floor model, in a wooden cabinet, doors and on casters. A letter is being sent to local residents asking for donations to help pay off the asking price, over what amount that the Teens have raised ,etc.

Browning expressed the Board's appreciation for Burke and Robertson's services as Director. Schwartz, Myers, Savage were welcombed as new Board Directors for their coming terms.

Burke thanked the Board saying it was a joy to serve them.

Burke and Robertson as outgoing Directors adjourned the meeting at 10:22P.M.

A. Contract Manager Sward presented a chart he has been recording the gals. per hour pumped and gals. per KW hours. He took a meter to West Marin Water Co. to be checked for accuracy. It was one of several he had overhauled and the meter checked out as 100% accurate. He is leaving on vacation starting December 28th. for ten days. Had filled some chuck holes on Lagoon Road and the railing on the Pacific Way slide to be completed with cinder blocks and a 2 foot high board fence. Thanked Michael Kaufman on his work done by the digging part of lateral ditch topside of Sunset Way and Ahab. His major expense coming up is filling gasoline tank.

Schwartz read a list of items needing attention. The ditches need cleaning, the retaining wall on Pacific Way; lights fixed on Community Center paths; color and smell of water being reported and safety of water for drinking; branches and garbage removed from around the Center. This list was given to Sward for his attention.

B. <u>Community Center Committee</u>: Kathy Sward reported no meeting was held this month. A special meeting had been called for the Child Care and she reported on that meeting. A lengthy discussion on licensing, infant care, administrators necessary, and insurance took place.

Andersdatter will draft a letter to be sent to Child Care Attorney, Gary
Friedman re: conditions that are mandatory and the only way the Board of
Directors can approve use of the Center by Child Care.1. The Child Care Center
permit is renewed by the County and when it fails to be renewed, the Child
Care program ceases to exist at Muir Beach.2. Insurance be in effect, and paid
by Child Care.3. The chairperson of Board of Directors (Child Care) attend
the CSD meetings monthly to keep the Board of Directors apprised of the
Child Care situations.

C. Fire Chief Sward reported the stairs in firebarn are completed; all has been quiet and thinks the department should be shaken up to be more active.

OLD BUSINESS:

A. Myers spoke on permanent road division. A post card election in a three month period of time is all that is needed. The County will be the active contractor. The resident establishes what he wants done, to be financed over a 10 year period; contractor takes care of maintenance. Annual costs per household estimate will be given before job is started.

Myers will get more information and Sward will follow through and they will

work together on their findings.

B. "Fish Eye" mirrors: Swartz made many inquiries with Traffic Division, County of Marin and will have more information at next CSD meeting. C. Travel-at-own-risk signs for Muir Beach roads will be looked into by Browning. He will get legal wording and he will report back to the Board at the next CSD meeting.

NEW BUSINESS:

A. Insurance coverage which has not been renewed for the District is

being pursued.
B. Unemployment Insurance:

Recent legislation amended the California . Unemployment Insurance Code to repeal the Local Public Entity Employees Fund (LPEEF) in effect since Jan 1978.

The District had two options as to methods of financing.

A. Payment of contributions by the Regular Contribution Rate (Tax) method. B. Pro-rated cost of benefits paid. Direct Reimbursement Method. After discussion, the Board opted for method "B". Our election may only be cancelled on January 1 of any year after it has been in effect for two calendar years. All were in favor of method "B".

ANNOUNCEMENTS:

Myers submitted his resignation as Director due to exposure re: liability "Deep Pocket" insurance crisis. To be effective as of this date 12/18/85. There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 9:48 P.M.
