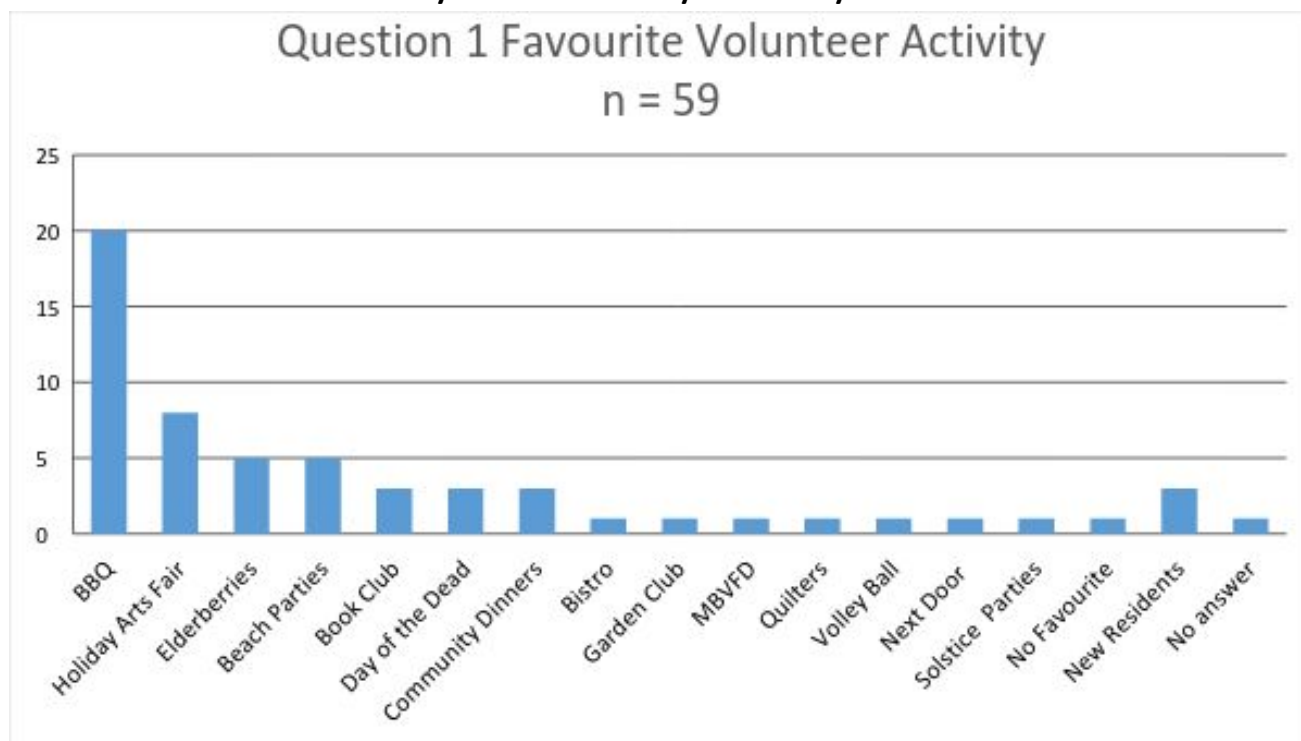


Question 1: Which is your favourite volunteer activity or organized Muir Beach community event? Why is this your favourite?



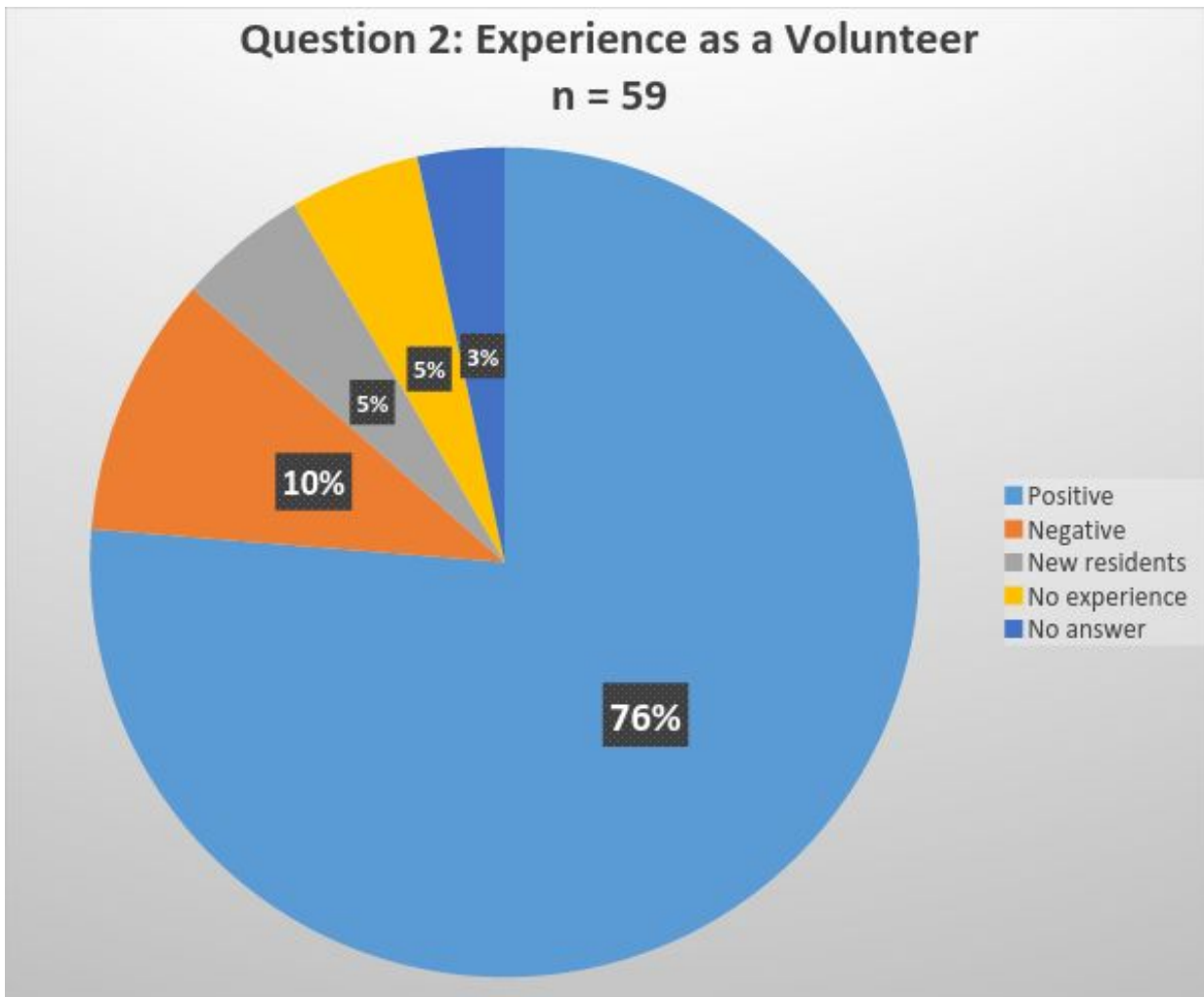

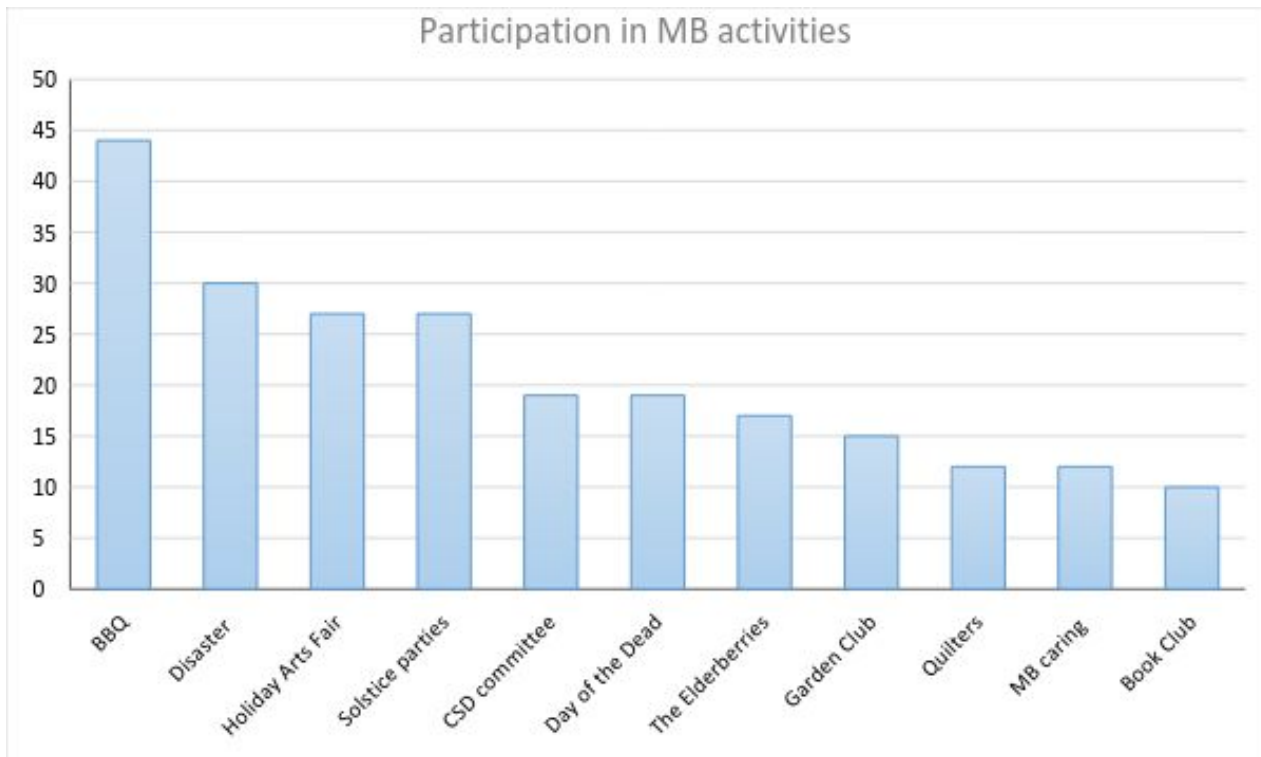
## Question 3b: Are there additional efforts you would like to help with to enable changes you want to see?

1. Clean up Committee

5. Replace dead pine tree across from The Pelican; Finance, build community swimming pool; Develop local (Muir Beach kids) involvement in Dairy and reintroduce training; Public safety and law enforcement
6. Brain storming group to gauge interest in greater security of homes
7. Better down lights on drive ways as they cause blinding when driving home at night
8. Update Community Centre; wine tasting event to draw people together
9. Feel its necessary to get younger people involved in volunteering
10. Blocked views; short term rentals living in a casual attitude which reduces our sense of a solid community

Question 4: Please indicate the community activities that you participate in and those that you consider volunteering for the future

Only one of the participant indicated that they have not participated in any of the Muir Beach activities. As expected the Muir Beach annual BBQ is the most popular activity.



The respondents showed great enthusiasm in supporting Muir Beach activities with 93% expressing an interest in volunteering in the future. The most popular activities that Muir Beachers are keen to help out with are; BBQ, Solstice parties and Muir Beach Caring.

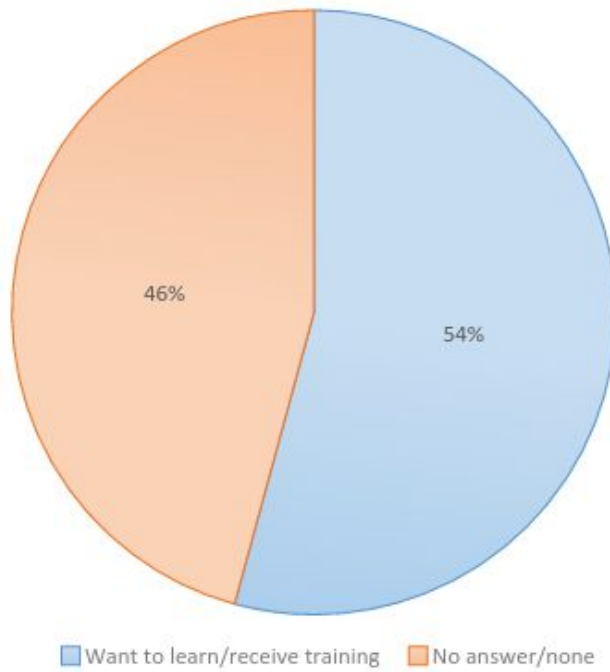

54% of respondents expressed an interest in developing new skills. First aid training, water hydrology, water quality analysis and web design were the most noted skills the group would like to develop.

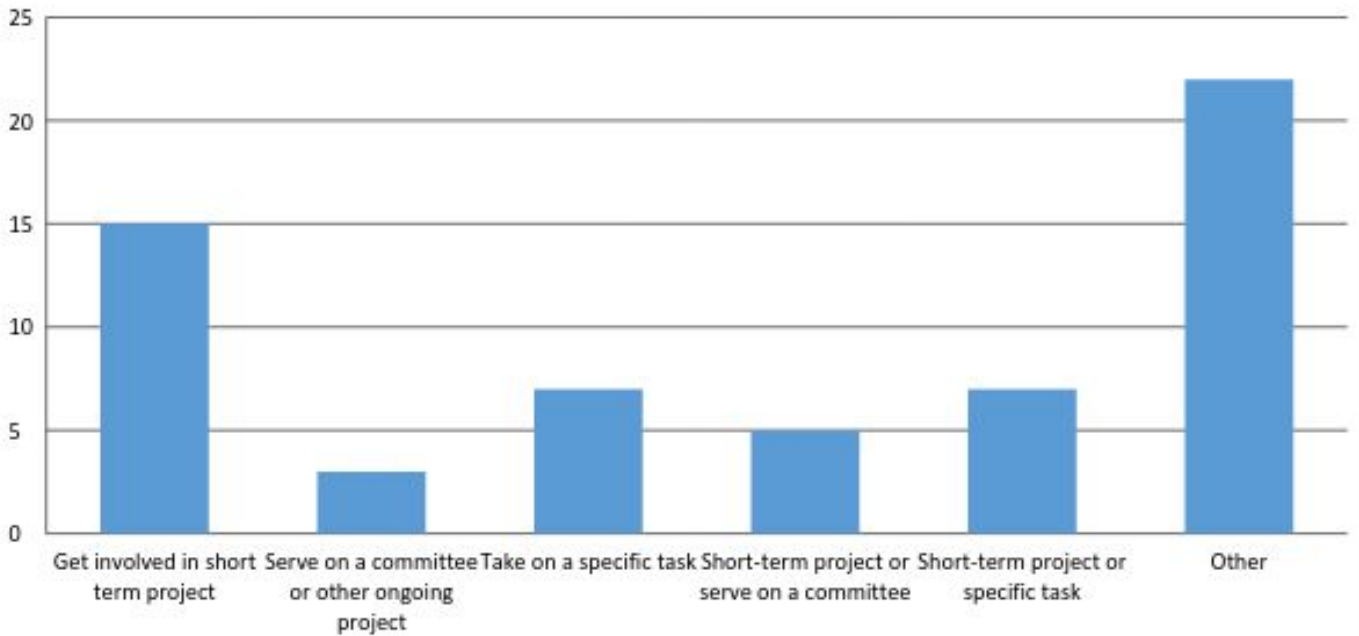
Question 5: Interest in developing skills

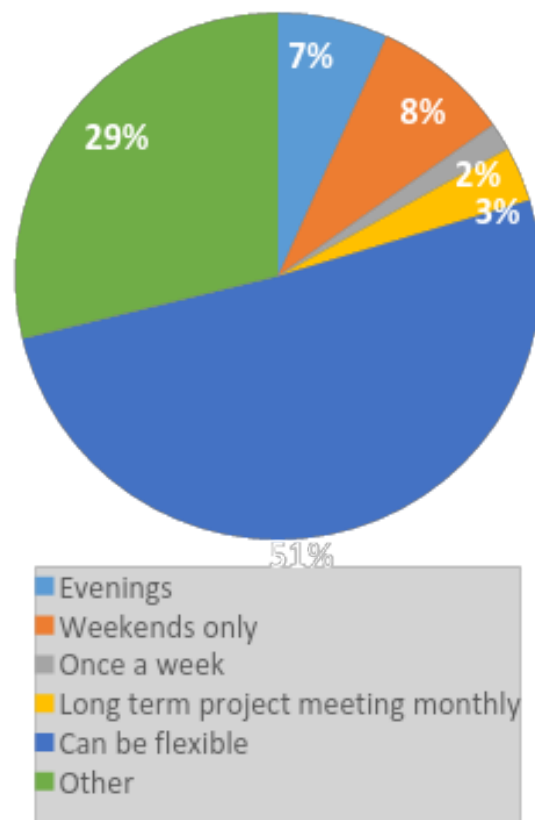
Question 7: What is your time availability to participate in Muir Beach

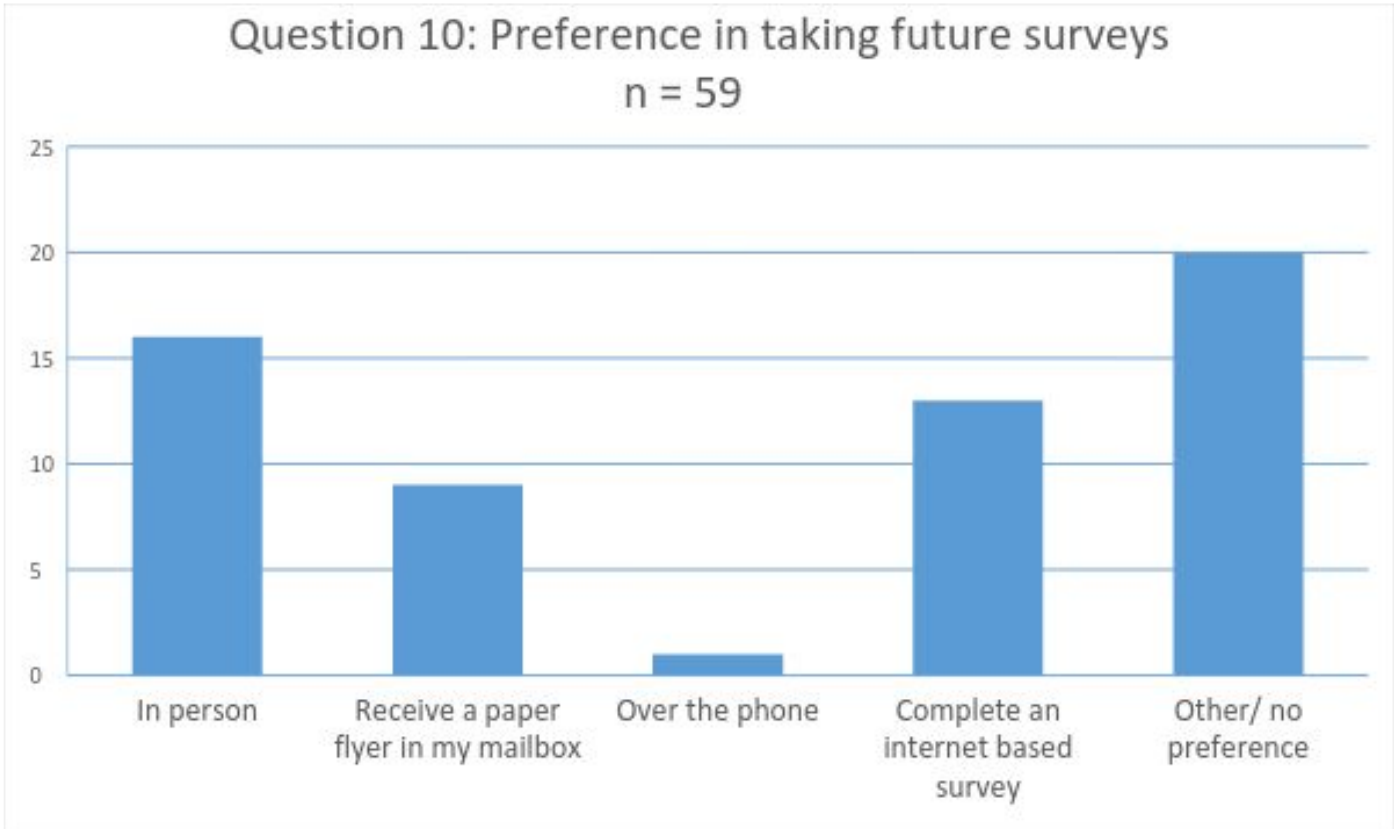
Eight responders have contacts which may be helpful to Muir beach and these are listed below:
